ABOUT MY WORK

There is a certain degree of absurd perception and irony in the stillness and the regulatory system of power that I attempt to grasp in my projects. What I am interested in is not related to a particular subject matter but the space, the interactions and regulations that form in it.

My work wants to start a conversation about the interactions that form in different spaces and their physicality. Sometimes it is socially involved, other times it involves only Voyager and its travels in interstellar space.

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My work celebrates the relationship that forms between physical, virtual and biological space, (be it real or imagined) and social interactions, within the constrains of the political landscape.

There is a nostalgic happiness what sways and alternates between political and psychological behaviour with double glazed humour and irony.
