The Life Of A Commuter series is a documentary portraits project intended to capture the everyday life of a commuter in Kuala Lumpur and its satellite city.

The main struggle in living in a city is the everyday commute from home to work. As the effort from the government grew in promoting the use of public transport, many Malaysian still opted the use of their personal transport until the completion of the first MRT (Mass Rapid Transport) line, the Sungai Buloh - Kajang Line (SBK Line) in 2017. With a total of 650'000 (according to the Land Public Transport Commission) commuters daily, MRT has become the backbone of commuters within the Klang Valley district.

The photo series, set throughout the MRT SBK Line, is to capture commuters within a set of space and time during my own commute to work. It is still an ongoing series.
