

SAFE PLACE

Safe place is a photographic and moving image project focused on raising awareness about gender violence that exists in southern Mexico.

The objective is to sensitize the public about the urgent need to heal the social wounds caused by violence, through a directive, conceptual and beautiful narrative, to emphasize the importance of building safe environments for our women.

Safe Place is a psychological deconstruction of six victims of gender violence narrated through visual tales about fantastic creatures; It is a story about resilience, unconditional love, justice and the return to origin to heal the wounds of the past.

Inspired by Mexican folklore and the magico-religious beliefs of the Southeast of the country, it seeks to make allegory to the virgin of Guadalupe maximum deity for Mexicans, who despite venerating a woman cannot prevent those who do not enjoy holy mantle be killed every two hours.

This project is an immersive way of telling a visual story that uses memory and performance in an equitable way to transform painful situations into an artistic object.
