

Shaima Al Tamimi is a Yemeni-Kenyan documentary photographer who was raised in the Emirates.

Her multi cultural upbringing influences her visual story telling where she focuses on diaspora stories, societal issues and food culture.

In 2016, she hosted a travel documentary series that aired on MBC TV highlighting stories of Arab women who empower their community through social entrepreneurship. She shortly joined the Everyday Middle East team that year.

She is the 2018 recipient of a grant by AFAC in association with the Magnum Foundation and Prince Claus Fund on documenting the hybrid heritage of Yemeni migrants who settled in specific parts of the world.
